West Valley City Facts:

- 129,480 citizens, Utah's second-most populous city (2011 Census estimate)
- 37,780 households, 38,978 housing units (2011 Census estimate)
- 50.8% male (2008 Census estimate); 49.6% female (2011 Census estimate)
- Over 40% of the population is between ages 25 and 54 (2008 Census estimate)
- 54.4% of the population is married (2008 Census estimate)
- Over 70% of the population is Caucasian; minority population is mainly Hispanic with a significant Asian/Pacific Islander community (2008 Census estimate)
- Median household income is \$56,500 (2008 Census estimate)
- Economic development efforts at the center of Utah's second--biggest city are moving forward full-force. The recent announcement of the City Center project –Fairbourne Station – and the continued development of the Valley Fair Mall are proving successful, as businesses and retailers continue to become involved with and thrive in one of the largest redevelopment projects in the state.
